What does our service do?

We provide education for pupils with severe or profound and multiple learning difficulties. Our highly specialist curriculum offer includes Sensory Support Teaching and Music Therapy

We are supported by Speech and Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists, and Physiotherapists

We are located in Bury St Edmunds and cover the West Suffolk Area.

We have an Assessment Nursery and full - time provision from Reception through to Post 16.

Access to Riverwalk is through a referral system to the Suffolk County Council SEN Department. Placement meetings are held termly, and referrals can be made throughout the year.
